The FLM program is designed to develop and enhance the leadership skills of the next generation of professionals who will guide and lead FPDA, the industry, and their companies.

Time and Travel Commitment

Participants can expect approximately (5) hours a month to participate in pre-scheduled webinars, (1) week in March to attend UID, and (3) days to attend the conference over two consecutive years.

Program Cost

Members contributing a volunteer mentor: \$5,100* per candidate.

Cost without contributing a mentor: \$5,600*.

Program fee includes:

- (2) consecutive registrations to the Industry Summit at the beginning and end of the program
- (1) registration for UID
- 1-on-1 coaching
- Access to the online learning management system
- Virtual presentations and workshops

Educational Credit

As an additional benefit, the time spent in the FLM Program can be applied to the Purdue University Professional Certificate of Innovative Distribution Programs continuing education requirements.

What is the FLM Program?

Future Leaders in Motion (FLM) is a content-rich, immersive leadership training program that reinforces leadership fundamentals with one-on-one coaching and mentorship. It is an incredible value available only to FPDA member companies.

FLM Program Overview

The 13-month program kicks off at the annual conference and concludes at the following. FLM participants gain new perspectives through one-on-one and group coaching from professional Executive Coach, Donna Gilligan, and are also partnered with a mentor from a non-competing FPDA member company.

Participants will take a D.I.S.C. assessment, participate in over 10 group discussions on key leadership topics, and will attend Purdue University's of Innovative Distribution in March of the program year.

Here is a snapshot of what candidates will gain individually and as a team:

- Mindsets of Leaders: The FLM Program encourages a growth in self-awareness and emotional intelligence by utilizing D.I.S.C. and weaving in the results & language throughout the year.
- Foundations of Leadership: Participants will grow a list of attributes all leaders need to understand. Topics will include developing trust, the value of reputation/rapport, and stewarding influence.
- Developing a Leadership Toolkit: Participants will be equipped with tools to greatly enhance their influence and be challenged to identify their next steps of impact as a leader.
- Mentoring and Coaching: Work closely with an industry mentor, participate in small group discussions, and receive personal guidance with one-on-one meetings by a professional career coach.
- University of Innovative Distribution: Participate in this concentrated educational program focused on the unique needs of the wholesale distribution industry.
- Financial Literacy for Leaders: Covering topics such as balance sheets, reading P&Ls, understanding organizational profitability, and benchmarking data to drive business decisions
